Job Description and Training for Roofers and Waterproofers

Roofers are responsible for the installation of various types of roofing systems which include, roof coverings and insulation systems for low and steep sloped roofs.

Roofing Systems include but are not limited to:

Built-up roofing; which includes hot tar applied or cold applied process.

Single-Ply membranes; which include Thermoplastic membranes (TPO, PVC, CPE, CSPE, PIB, NBP, EIP, ETFE), EPDM, Neoprene and Butyl rubber whether loose laid, mechanically attached or fully adhered and Modified Bitumen whether hot applied, cold applied, or torch applied.

Shingles, Slate and Tile; used for the installation of steep slope roofing systems.

Insulation systems include; various types of flat and tapered board stock insulations attached using various mechanical fasteners or adhesives. Spray on foam insulation systems and coverings.

Reroofing responsibilities include removal of existing roof systems, inspection of substrate (decking) and the installation of the new roofing system on either low or steep sloped roofs.

Waterproofing/ Dampproofing and Air barriers; includes below ground, basin, plaza deck, walls and all other locations where applicable.

Training: APPRENTICES

1st Year; Roofers Safety and Health, OSHA 30, ICRA, First Aid/CPR

2nd Year; Built-up Roofing and Waterproofing/Dampproofing

3rd Year; Single- Ply Roofing and Waterproofing/Dampproofing, Air Barriers, CERTA, First Aid/CPR

4th Year; Steep Slope, Rigging/Signaling

Recertification of First Aid/CPR, OSHA 30, CERTA, Rigging & Signaling and ICRA as required.
