### Minimum Requirements for Apprentice Roofer Are:

- 1.) Be of legal working age, eighteen (18) years old.
- 2.) Be physically able to perform the manual work of the trade. (A Roofer should have no fear of height, a good sense of balance, and a better than average sense of safety for him/herself and their co-workers. They should enjoy working with their hands and accept working outdoors, sometimes under unpleasant working conditions.)
- 3.) Social Security Card or Birth Certificate for 1-9 use.
- 4.) Be of good moral character.
- 5.) Applicants are required to provide a physical examination.
- 6.) Applicants must pass a drug test prior to acceptance into the program.

### Roofers & Waterproofers Local 37 Apprenticeship Application Process/ Procedure and Apprenticeship Program Progression.

1. Apply Online at:

2. Roofers Local 37 Apprenticeship office will send the application to our signatory contractors.
3. The individual Signatory contractors will review applications and decide to contact applicant for interview.
4. When interview is completed, contractor will decide to hire applicant.
5. When hired and prior to starting work Applicant will:
  - a. Attend Apprenticeship Orientation.
  - b. Sign Apprenticeship Agreement
  - c. Provide valid Photo Identification.
  - d. Provide Social Security Card
  - e. Schedule, complete and pass a drug test with Mobile Medical (cost of drug test paid by Roofers Local 37).
  - f. Submit a work physical prior to start of work (cost of physical is applicant's responsibility).
6. Follow the responsibilities of apprentice for wage increases.
7. After six (6) months service and the six hundred (600) hour probationary period an Apprentice 1 will be eligible to start training classes and will be notified of training classes dates and times and be moved to Apprentice 2 status, provided they have satisfactorily completed the requirements of the Apprenticeship Program.
8. Then every six months and six hundred hours Apprentice will be moved to the next level of apprenticeship.
9. At the end of four years and minimum of 4800 hours worked Apprentice will become a Journeyman Roofer/ Waterproofers.
10. All Wage Increases are Based on Satisfactorily Completing the Requirements of the Apprenticeship Program
